His father was the leading clergyman of the Unitarian denomination in Central Massachusetts; was honored with the degree of D.D. by his Alma Mater, Harvard College; was the author of a standard Life of Washington which has been republished in England and has also been recently reprinted in this country in popular form; was Vice-President of the American Antiquarian Society for many years; was President of the American Unitarian Association from its organization in 1825 to 1836; and was a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. His mother was a daughter of Judge John Chandler, and was a recognized leader among the women of the little town in which her lot was cast. Her time during married life was engrossed in the care of a large family of children, who were reared in a manner suited to their social position, with no other income ordinarily at command than her husbands salary...
